BALLOT MEASURE X434

PROPOSAL

This proposition increases the members of the Board of Chiropractic Examiners from five to seven and requires that both of the new members be from the general public, that is, not licensed chiropractors. The proposition also makes minor changes in: (1) the eligibility requirements for an approved chiropractic school or college and (2) the license application period, and the education and examination requirements for state licensing of chiropractors.
